

Notice on the Supply Chain Appeals Mechanism of Changan Automobile

I. Purpose

Chongqing Changan Automobile Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "Changan Automobile" or "the Company"), driven by a mission to lead sustainable mobility and benefit human life, continuously advances its three major strategies: the Green Plan, the Intelligent Plan and the Vast Ocean Plan. As part of this process, the Company adheres to long-term development, localization and systematic capacity building while implementing responsible ESG practices. Changan Automobile accelerates its global presence through transparent and trustworthy partnerships, and co-creates an open, mutually beneficial and sustainable supply chain ecosystem.

Based on the above strategic direction, the Company has formulated and continuously updated the Changan Automobile Code of Conduct for Business Partners, and requires all suppliers to sign the Changan Automobile Notice on Joint Integrity Building, thereby establishing a strong foundation for compliant partnerships. To deepen strategic mutual trust and foster an open and transparent cooperative environment, the Notice on Supply Chain Appeals Mechanism of Changan

Automobile (hereinafter referred to as "the Notice") is hereby formulated. All employees of Changan Automobile's business partners, subcontractors and other stakeholders are encouraged to use appropriate channels for inquiries, violation reporting and appeals.

II. Scope of Appeals

The appeals process can be used to address the following violations:

- 1) Acts that violate the Changan Automobile Code of Conduct for Business Partners, the Changan Automobile Notice on Joint Integrity Building, the supplementary agreements on supply chain due diligence of Changan Automobile and other applicable policies and procedures;
- 2) Acts that violate domestic and international laws, regulations or regulatory requirements;
- 3) Acts that may subject the Company to economic losses, reputational damage or other adverse impacts.

III. Submission of Appeals

Appellants shall submit comprehensive appeal details and all

supporting evidence. Appeals deemed out of scope or lacking sufficient substantiation will not be processed. For inquiries regarding the Notice, please send them to the e-mail address above.

IV. Processing of Appeals

The Company will evaluate the appeals received and initiate internal investigations as necessary. If the reported party is verified to have violated regulations, strict sanctions will be imposed in accordance with corporate policies. Any act constituting a criminal offense will be referred to the judicial authorities.

The Company maintains a blacklist system to monitor and manage suppliers who breach integrity and credit regulations, thereby safeguarding the integrity and standardization of the supply chain, in accordance with the Supplier Blacklist Management Procedure and the T3 Supplier Joint Integrity and Credit Sharing and Cooperation Mechanism. Meanwhile, the Company undertakes regular evaluations of internal controls and audit supervision across high-risk business areas such as procurement and R&D, to effectively prevent commercial bribery and ethical risks.

V. Protection of Appellants

A comprehensive whistle-blower protection mechanism is in

place to safeguard the legitimate rights and interests of appellants, ensuring the confidentiality of their identities and guaranteeing they will not be subjected to any unfair treatment resulting from their reporting. To further strengthen the integrity protection network, Changan Automobile hereby stipulates the following requirements for all business partners:

Business partners shall ensure their directors, management, employees and agents comply with the requirements of the Notice. They shall not take any retaliatory measures, including demotion, salary reduction or termination of cooperation against any appellant or organization.

Business partners shall effectively communicate the provisions of the Notice and the communication channels to their employees and suppliers, including in languages familiar to them.

VI. Supplementary Provisions

The Notice shall take effect as of the date of issuance. The Company will update the content of the Notice as needed to comply with the latest regulations and shall reserve the right of interpretation.
